May you all pray for me, too.



WHAT IS PRAYER?

Prayer, or Dua, means to call, to reach out to, or to ask for help. A servant knows that Allah protects them and gives them everything that they need.

What do we need as people?

We need many things, so everyone asks Allah for whatever they need. For example:

- Whoever needs a house, or a car
- Whoever wants to study at a good school, or have a good job
- Whoever wants to have beautiful children
- Whoever wants health, or peace
- Whoever wants to be forgiven for their mistakes

So, what is it that you want?

Do you want to be happy together with your family, to be healthy and successful?



Maybe you want to have good friends and play fun games.

Who are you going to ask for these things?

Won't you ask Allah for them? Of course, because...

He created the world, the sun, the moon and the stars.

He created the mountains, the seas and the forests.

He created the animals, the plants, and all microscopic life.

He created you, me, and all people. He created the joy that is inside of us.

He created everything, and He is capable of all things.

So what can we do?

We can't do anything before we have Allah's permission, right?

If He wants, we will eat and drink.

If He wants, we will pass our exams.

If He wants, we will love one another.

If He doesn't want us to, then we can't even breathe!

WE ONLY SEEK HELP FROM ALLAH

"It is Allah who has made the earth a dwelling place for you and made the sky a canopy, who shaped you and shaped you exceedingly well and gave you good things as sustenance. That is Allah, your Lord; blessed be Allah, the Lord of the Universe. He is the Ever-Living: there is no god but He. So call upon Him, giving to Him all your devotion. All praise and thanks be to Allah, the Lord of creation."

(Surah al-Mu'min, Ayahs 40, 64 and 65)

Allah created everything that exists. Birds fly with Allah's permission. Flowers bloom with Allah's permission. Our families raise us with Allah's permission. Just like the rest of creation, we too ask Allah for love, protection and ease in our work. That's because we know that only Allah is capable of all things. Allah the Supreme taught us that we should only ask Him for help in Surah al-Fatiha by saying, "Only You will we worship and only You will we ask for help."

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If that's true then what do you say to this prayer: "Oh Allah!

I open my hands Only to You.
When I pray to You,
I feel like I could
fly with the birds.
When I think of You,
My heart swells up with joy.
And when I pray to You,
My face beams with a smile."

Our Supreme Lord sent the prophets to instruct His servants in the best way. They also called people to the way of Allah. When the last prophet, Prophet Muhammad (s), was carrying out his sacred but difficult duty, he trusted only in Allah. He only asked for help from Him in his prayers. Since our dear Prophet (s) really loved all Muslims, we too should be like him, and

turn only to Allah in our prayers.





Umar (r) said, "Before I was a Muslim, we made idols out of halvah. When we were hungry we ate them. I laugh when I remember this." Can you imagine that? In those days they worshipped idols made out of halvah and later they ate them. How can an idol, that cannot even protect itself, protect people? How can an idol, which has never heard of love, teach people how to love? How can an idol, which cannot help people and cannot stand on its

own feet, ever help the world to stand on its own feet? As soon as the Prophet (s) was born, the idols in the Kaaba began to collapse because Allah willed it. Isn't it funny? People put their hopes in idols that can't even get up when they fall!



Isn't it nice to go for a drive in a fancy car? In the time of our Prophet (s), riding a horse or a camel was a very fun thing for children. If they were to ride the camel or horse of our Prophet (s), then they would be simply flying with happiness.

One day, our dear Prophet (s) took one of the children of that time, Abdullah, up onto his camel with him. Abdullah hugged our Prophet (s) tightly and listened to his sweet words. Our Prophet (s) counselled him in this way:



"When you want something, ask Allah for it. When you need help with something, ask Allah for help. Know that if all of creation came together to do something for you, they could only do it with Allah's permission. Also, if all of creation united together to harm you, they could not hurt you if Allah did not allow it. Know, also, that Allah's help is for those who are patient, and that with every difficulty comes relief." During Abdullah's whole life, he never forgot our dear Prophet's (s) words that were as valuable as gold, or his hug, which was so full of happiness. He told Allah all of his wishes, and asked only Him for help.
