Alper said,

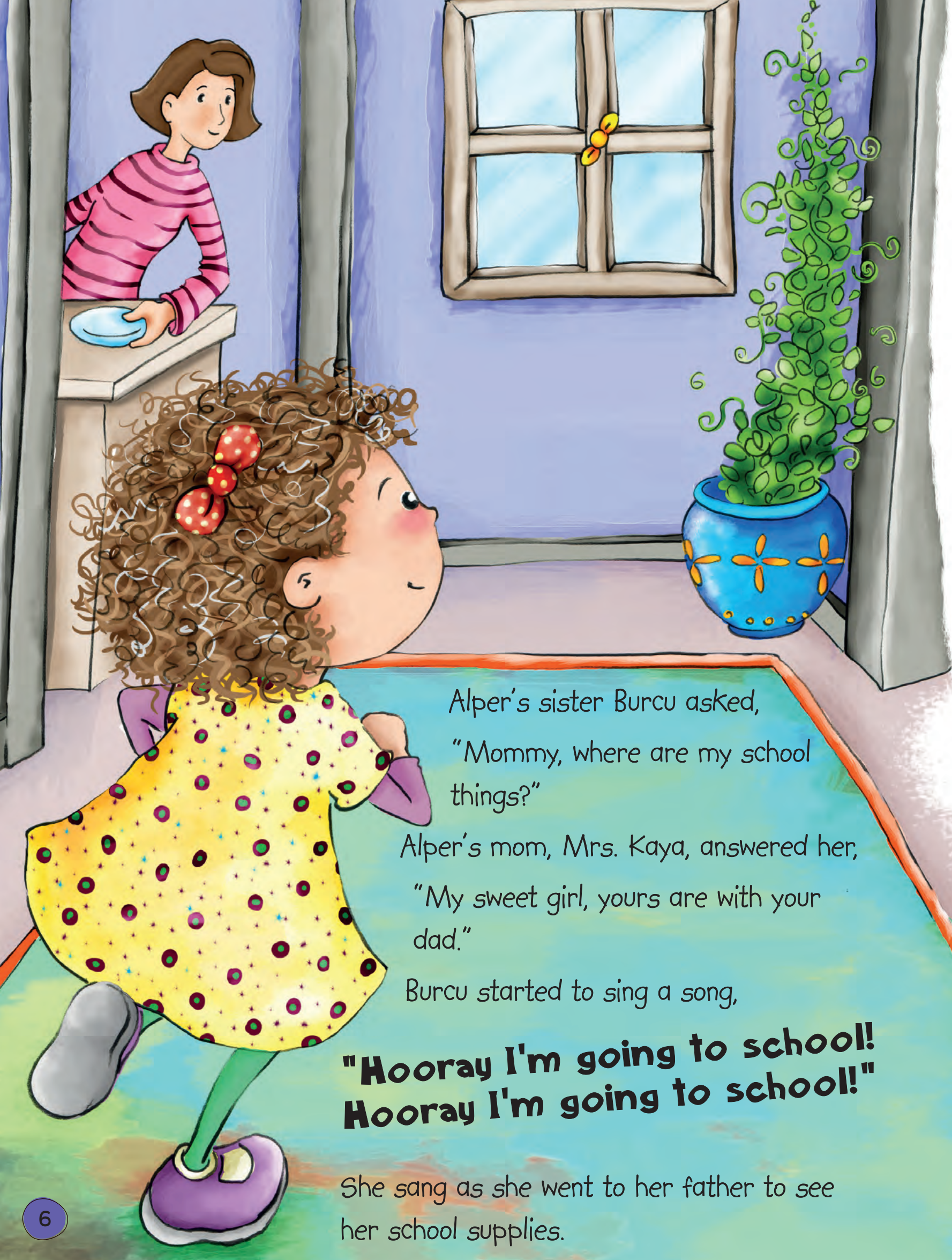
"New books and pens, hooray, hooray!"
