The man in the picture is Alper's dad, Mr. Kaya.

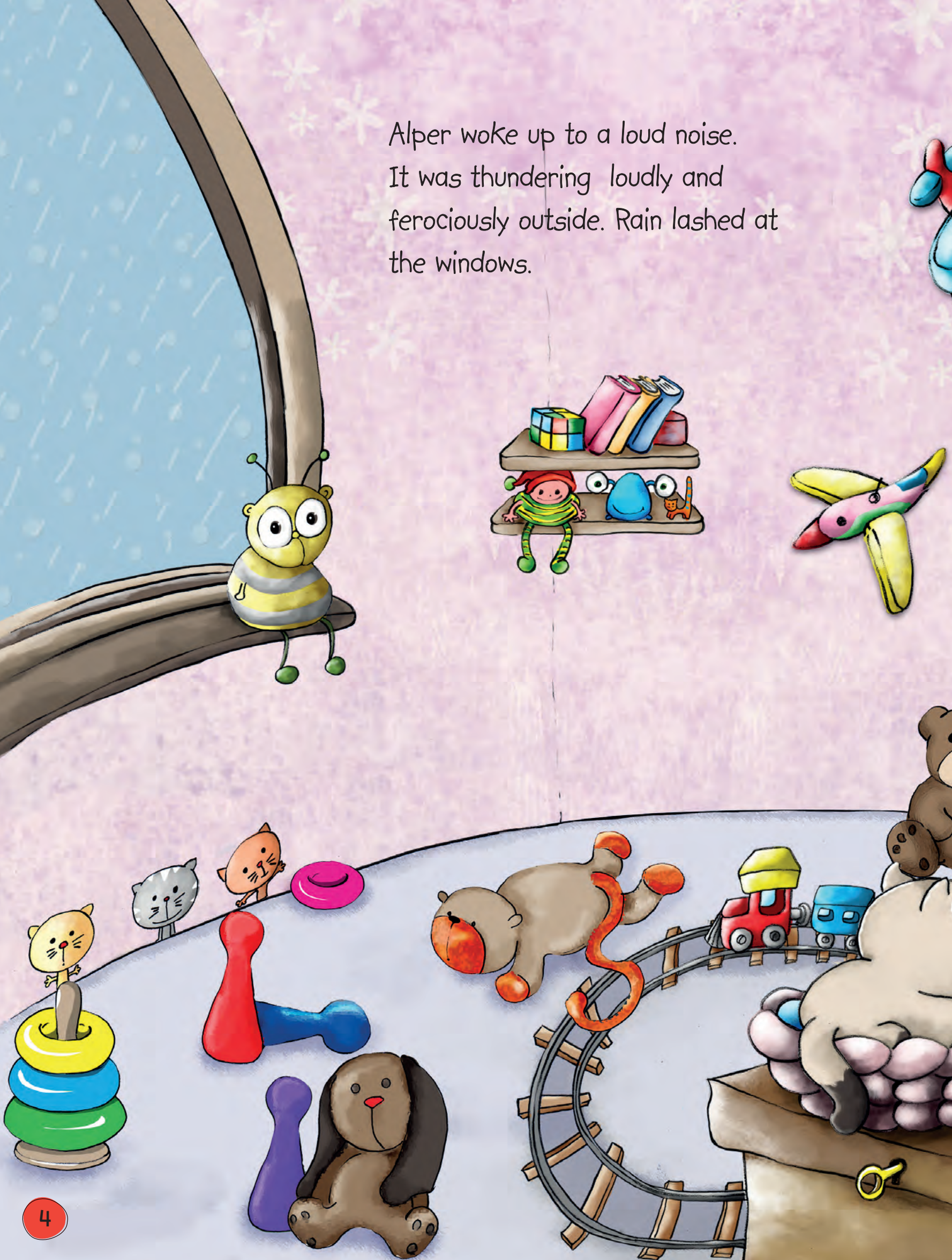
Alper knows his dad is very strong. He can carry big heavy shopping bags.

the windows.

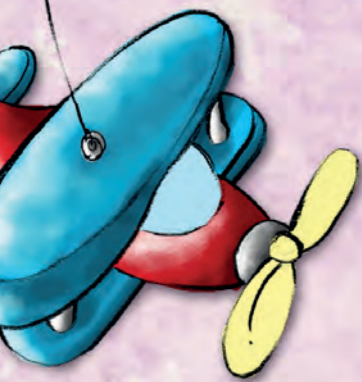


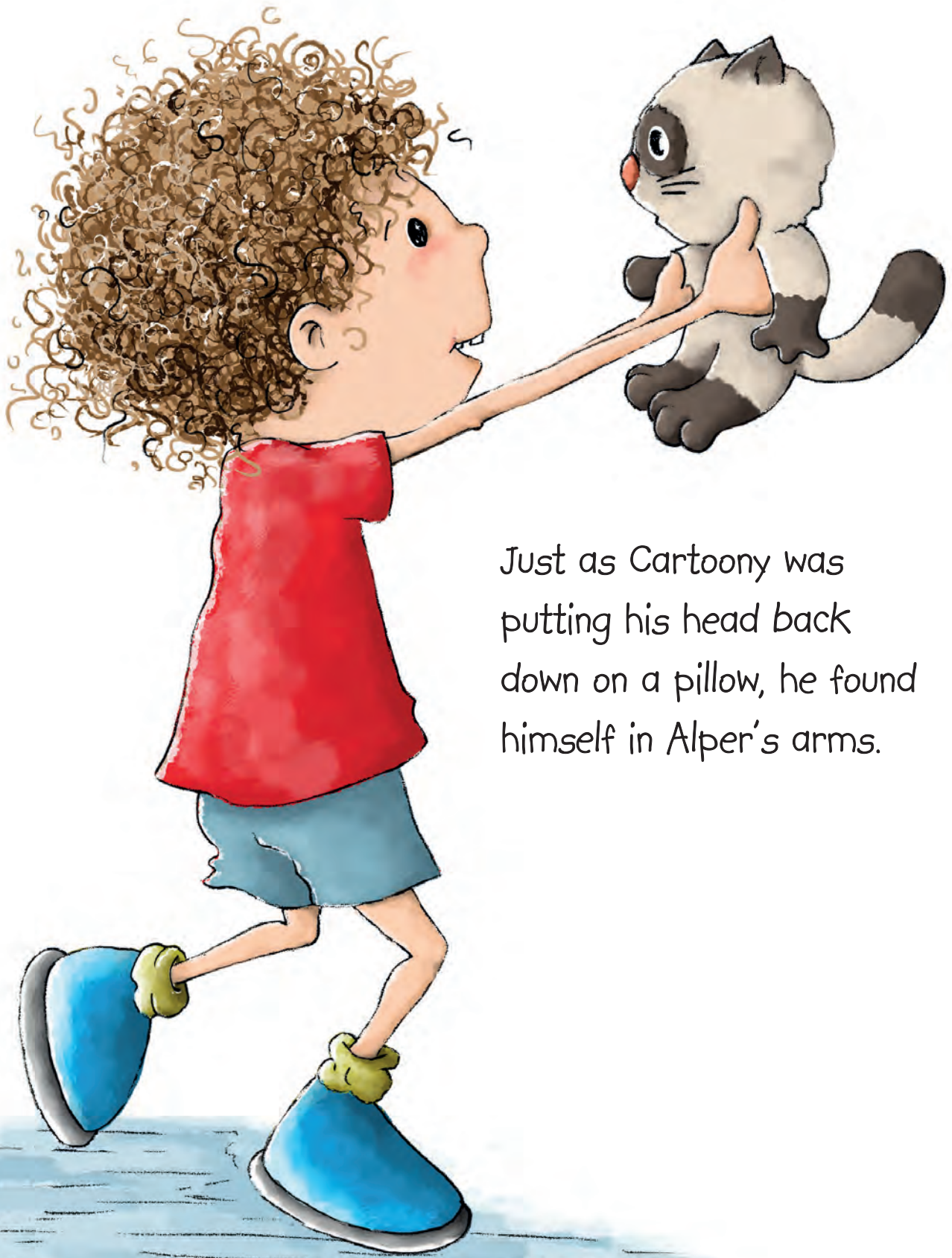
Alper called out,
